a
Shoulder to shoulder

Wearing a comfortable t-shirt, measure from the seam at the end of one shoulder to the other

b
Middle of neck to wrist

Measure from the middle of the neck to the wrist

(CAMERA SUIT ONLY)
While wearing your rig, measure from armpit to top of lateral

b²
Armpit to top lateral

(CAMERA SUIT ONLY)
While wearing your rig, measure from the top of lateral to just below the legstrap

b
Top lateral to below

c
Middle of neck to elbow

Measure from the middle of the neck to the elbow

d
Flexed

Measure around the bicep while flexed

e
Wrist

Measure around wrist

e²
Forearm

Measure around forearm

f
Chest

Measure around the chest while breathing in

g
Upper Body

Measure from the hole in the throat, around the crotch, to the back of middle of the neck

g²
Waistband (PANTS ONLY)

Measure around your body at the position where you want the waistband of the pants to rest

(PANTS ONLY)
Measure from where the waistband measurement G2 was taken around the crotch and back to the waistband

g³
Front waist to back

h
Waist

Measure natural waist at bellybutton

h²
Hole in throat to

Measure from the hole in the throat to your bellybutton

i
Hips

Measure around hips at the widest point

j
Thigh

Measure around thigh at the widest point

k
Crotch to knee

Measure from the crotch seam to the top of the knee

l
Crotch to

Measure from the crotch seam to the floor

m
Ankle

Measure around ankle

m²
Calf

Measure around calf

n
Neck

Measure around neck from the hole in the throat

o
Cup size

(WOMEN ONLY)
The letters of your bra size. For example, for a 36 D, it would only be D

Measuring

- ALWAYS have someone measure you
- Take all measurements while wearing clothes you would wear under your jumpsuit.
- When measuring make sure the tape is not too tight. It should be comfortable and relaxed.
- Take all measurements at the widest point
- Take all measurements twice to confirm
- If the measurement is in between (1/4 - 1/2 - 3/4) always round up to the highest number
- Do not add or subtract from your measurements to get a baggier/tighter suit as it will result in your suit not fitting and alteration fees
