

























































## Measuring

- · ALWAYS have someone measure you
- Take all measurements while wearing clothes you would wear under your jumpsuit
- When measuring make sure the tape is not too tight. It should be comfortable and relaxed.
- · Take all measurements at the widest point
- Take all measurements twice to confirm
- If the measurement is in between ( 1/4 1/2 3/4 ) always round up to the highest number
- Do not add or subtract from your measurements to get a baggier/tighter suit as it will result in your suit not fitting and alteration fees
